Vendor Form

All vendors will be assigned booths as registrations are received. The locations of your booth spots may be different than previous years. All food vendors will be given first choice of electricity spots.

- Restricts the sale of the following: Illegal drugs, **drug related paraphernalia**, flea market or yard sale items, real weapons, fireworks, stink products, merchandise of a racial nature, obscenities or products of an offensive nature of any kind will not be permitted.
- Absolutely NO GENERATORS for food or food related vendors.
- Heavy duty outdoor electric cords-ONLY. Power cords are subject to inspection by City Elec. Dept.
- Food vendors must meet NM Environmental Health Office regulations for food service and have their certificates in view.
- Vendors will need to provide your own tables, chairs and displays. Vendors are responsible for their own set up of their booth and the physical appearance of your booth area and are expected to keep clean.
- **If you require more than the allotted 12 x 12 space, you must purchase an additional booth. FOOD VENDORS REQUIRE MORE SPACE _ KEEP This in Mind when paying for your spots.**
- Vendors must remove trash in booth vicinity, receptacles will be provided. There will be no rain date or refunds for NO shows

Set-up/ Hours of Operation/ Teardown:

T or C Fiesta will be held at Ralph Edwards Park, downtown Truth or Consequences. Vendors may set up as early as 12pm, Friday, May 5 2017. Set-up on Saturday, May 6 may begin as early as 8am. Tear down must be completed by 8pm Sunday, May 7, 2015. Vendors are expected to operate for the majority of the event Saturday and Sunday.

Insurance and hold harmless: All vendors and exhibitors must have their own liability insurance. Vendor is solely responsible for all dealings, actions and holds T or C Fiesta Inc. harmless from all claims.

Legal Compliance/ Taxes: Vendor agrees to comply with all local and state laws, licensing, permits, and health department regulations. Vendors are solely responsible for payment of all state and local sales tax as a result of any sales made during this event.

Questionable Products: T or C Fiesta Inc. reserves the right to inspect, approve, reject or otherwise control the display, promotion or sale of products. Any objectionable items must be removed from the booth by the vendor or may be removed by T or C Fiesta Inc.

Termination of agreement: T or C Fiesta Inc. reserves the right to terminate this agreement at any time without prior notice if the terms of this agreement are not met or any policies are violated. Inappropriate conduct, lewd behavior or the encouraging of lewd behavior, foul or offensive language, nudity, serving or consuming alcoholic beverages in vending space, drug use, intoxication or other illegal activities, violation of terms of this contract, laws or ordinances, fire department regulation or codes, or health department regulations.
